Local and nonlocal interactions in some mathematical models


This international conference aims to investigate the new research directions and solve important open problems associated with problems with mixed subcritical-critical-supercritical regime in the local and nonlocal abstract settings.

There is at present no efficient approach for the study of blow-up boundary solutions of fully nonlinear elliptic equations (Bellman, Monge-Ampère, Isaacs, and Gaussian curvature equations) and nonlocal problems (fractional Laplace, Choquard, Schrödinger Kirchhoff equations).

Our meeting addresses some gaps in existing knowledge: nonlinear systems with mixed regime, blow-up and singular phenomena in nonlocal setting, Karamata theory for fully nonlinear and nonlocal settings.
